We are prisoners of hope:

“As for you also, Because of the blood of your covenant, I will set your prisoners free from the waterless pit. Return to the stronghold, You prisoners of hope. Even today I declare That I will restore double to you.” Zech. 9:11-12 NKJV

As we learn to live from grace by faith we will walk with an expectation of good. We are not in a prison of hopelessness and fear, but we became prisoners of hope and no one can rob us from our hope in Christ.

Hope is having a positive expectation of good in life. As children of God, our lives belong to Him. We are God's property, the apple of His eye! He will protect and takes care of us. We are locked up in Christ! We cannot come out of Him. Even when the enemy wants to rob us, God restores double. When something has been broken in your life, don't give up and end up in hopelessness. There is no hopeless case for God. Be quick to trust God for His restoration when something has been stolen from you. When the enemy comes against you one way, he will flee from you in seven ways. The thief, the devil, has to give back to you double. Declare restoration in your life when things and relationships have been broken and destroyed. Don't stay silent in a state of hopelessness and condemnation. God's grace can work out something good for you. God is in the business of restoration, and when He does it, you can be sure it'll be good.

Things have been different for us since I was diagnosed with 2 different types of cancer last June. I have not been able to travel and work as before. But after going through 2 operations and radiation treatments, things are looking better. I

will have some major body tests in late January and I am trusting the Lord for healing and restoration of my health. I have started working with administration paperworks and maintaining contacts with our coworkers and partners in the ministry. I have not started travelling and ministering yet, but I trust the Lord that I will be able to do that soon. Even though we have not been able to travel to the mission field and work as we used to, the Lord has continued to work in a powerful way through our coworkers. By our partners prayers and faithful support, we have been able to help, support, and send financial assistance to our co workers in the mission field.

We are so grateful for your support for the ministry, which allows things to continue growing by God's grace. Many of the plans we had have been delayed, but we believe that everything will work out for good as we trust and believe in God. In the midst of all that's happening, we know that what happened on the cross is incredibly powerful, and God's grace leads us to the places He has prepared for us. We wish you all a blessed and prosperous 2024, and we want to say a big thank you again for your prayers and support for us and the mission work. May grace and peace be with you and your family.

Mission reports: This is our first newsletter since May last year, so I'll share what has happened in our ministry since July. I was really concerned about what would happen to the mission when I was hit by cancer, but by God's grace, we can still be involved in praying and supporting the work. The word that has been sown

through our outreach and seminars is bearing fruit and continues to bear fruit. God has raised up many workers who bring the good news to the unreach people and also the raising up of new churches in many places.

Our focus in our mission work in the last few years has been Nepal and North East India, where there are still tribes and people groups that have never heard the gospel or with few churches. By the grace of God, many people have been reached, and new house groups and churches have been started. Additionally, new individuals have been trained and equipped to bring the good news. I'm excited to hear about some of the things that have happened! I also receive reports from our contacts that people are being sent to different nations to bring the gospel to their respective people groups. For example one of the new area of outreach of our Nepali contact pastor is in North East India border close to Nepal, we receive reports of many being reach and baptised in that area, however they face persecution and most of the time their lives are in danger, so let's keep our contacts and these new believers in our prayers.

In Assam North East India, we continue to support the Himalayan Bible Institute with 20 students this year. Many of these students went on to start new churches after graduation. One student from Arunachal now has 400 church members. Our contact also travels and conducts seminars and training. In Manipur, there was an outbreak of tribal problems where many people were killed and lost their homes. However, amidst this, 10 young people were saved and many were touched by the Lord. In Assam, the church has experienced persecution, but praise the Lord, people have been baptized and new churches have been planted. Recently, two new churches have been planted and new house fellowships have started in areas where there were no churches. People have received the gospel and been baptized. Nine girls got saved and baptized two weeks ago. We're also supporting the construction of a new church building, and it is progressing step by step. We pray that it will be completed soon. Having a place of worship in the North East is crucial to help the poor villages in the area.

The work in Magani Church Ministry, Chitwan, Nepal, is continuing to grow. The workers are being trained and equipped for the ministry. Pastor Luke has trained 450 people in 24 leadership programs. A team has been sent out to remote and unreached mountain villages, resulting in 108 baptisms, the start of 4 new churches, and 10 new

house groups from August until November. It's incredible to see the impact of the ministry!

Pastor Manik leads the Full Life Church Ministry in Kathmandu, Nepal. The outreach team focuses on towns, mountain villages in Nepal, and places in North India near the Nepal border. According to Pastor Manik, approximately 4,300 people have heard the gospel, and 932 individuals have responded and accepted Christ. Recently, 67 people were baptized, and since August until November, 14 new churches have been planted. It's amazing to see the impact of the ministry!

Please keep in your prayer for Revival Mission's work and all our contacts in the different nations. Thank you for continual support, I trust that the Lord will bring health and restoration so we can continue to reach nations with the good news.
