“And when he had consulted with the people, he appointed those who should sing to the LORD, and who should praise the beauty of holiness, as they went out before the army and were saying: “Praise the LORD, For His mercy endures forever. Now when they began to sing and to praise, the LORD set ambushes against the people of Ammon, Moab, and Mount Seir, who had come against Judah; and they were defeated.” 2 Chr 20:21-22

In this verse in the book of Corinthians, Apostle Paul takes this image from a Roman triumph train. It was a spectacular celebration parade held in the ancient city of Rome for a military commander who had won an important victory on the battlefield. Granted by the Senate, it was a lavish and entertaining parade march which is suppose to instill into the people of the glory of Rome and its military superiority above all other nations. The defeated enemies were force to carry incense vessels spreading a fragrance of incense that would

rise as a offering to the Romans gods.

In our walk with the Lord, we often encounter opposition and difficulties, and the secret to victory is when we keep our focus on who we are in Christ and our victory is found in Him. He has brought us into a new position in him, it's a place of security and a place of rest, in God's righteousness, favor, and blessing.

Keep on walking and believing that we are in Him and let the power of His grace work out things in our favor. We don't respond to our challenges with complaining and uttering unbelief, but we keep our focus on the Lord by casting our cares on him and giving thanks and praise for our victory in Christ. The Lord is good and his grace and loving kindness endures forever.

On our last mission trip to India, we truly encountered difficulties and challenges in every program we had planned. It looks like all our programs should fail. But the Lord gave me these verses before my trip and by the grace of God what looked like would be a failure turn out to be a great victory in every place we came. God's grace and favor caused us to triumph in Christ. Don't let disappointment and bitterness take hold of your emotions when you encounter diffi-

Mission report: Here is a short report of our mission work from the period of late November last year to April 2023. We want to thank everyone who has been upholding the ministry with your prayers and financial support. We do sense when people uplift us in prayer. Sometimes we have

to do like Nehemiah when they rebuild the walls of Jerusalem. The opposition was great and they have to work with one hand and fight with the sword using the other.

In late November last year I visited the Philippines. We had a two days of meetings and seminar in Baler together with the team from Temple of Praise churches in Luzon. We also had revival meetings in the main church and in San Mateo. People were won-

derfully touched by the power and presence of God in the meetings.

In December we had the privilege to visit Vietnam again. We had two pastors and leader seminars in Da Lat and Hoi An. In Da Lat we had pastors from 11 churches where we taught and fellowship from morning to evening. In Hoi An many were very touched by the Lord and encouraged by the teachings. We also had meetings in local churches. Many young people were very hungry to learn more from the word of God.

In February we had the privilege to minister in Greece again. We had wonderful meetings in the Apostolic Church of Thessaloniki with Pastor Paul and Mary Demetriades. We also visited churches in the city of Larisa and Katerina. In all the meetings we felt the Lord brought encouragement and joy, it was a wonderful atmosphere of God's presence in every meeting.

In March we had 3 weeks filled with meeting programs in Chennai and Orissa. It was the first time to visit Jesus Touch church in Chennai since my friend Pastor Arthur went home to be with Jesus. I stayed with the family and was encouraged to see things go well despite many challenges. We had prayer meetings every day and a one-day

teaching seminar and had two Sunday services in the church. Pastor Berin, Pastor Arthur's son now leads the church together with his mother Pastor Jane and his sister, he also followed and join our program in Orissa. We traveled for one and a half hours with plane and 6 hours by car to reach our destination in Orissa. We had a pastor and leader seminar and 3 revival programs in different towns. We also had meetings in one Baptist and one Pentecost church on Sunday. The revival program was very successful but there was much disturbances and threats to stop the meetings. But by the grace of God, we enjoyed great favor from the people and authorities and the weather conditions were very good. Many hundreds of people responded to the Gospel

and there were also many healing testimonies. All kinds of body pain, eyes sight, and hearing problems were healed. People that could not walk properly were healed and restored. One woman with stomach conditions since birth was totally healed. In all the meetings we had a strong and wonderful atmosphere of joy and peace and it brought great unity among local churches, the people really enjoy the presence of God. We also provided food after the meetings as there were many at the meeting who are from different faraway villages. When we should go back to the airport, it was a 6 hours drive and we were not sure we could reach our destination as there was a road strike, all roads were close as they stop access for public transport. There were road gantry blockade with guards. We were stopped at the different gantries but somehow it was miracle after miracle we were able to drive through and went pass all the control post and onto our departure airport, the Lord brought us to the airport in time. Looking back we could not not have make it the the airport without God's intervention.

We also had meetings in the local churches and groups in Norway.

Please do keep us in your prayer, that the Lord leads us to the right place at the right time. There are many needs and challenges in the mission fields, your prayers and

financial support will truly bless and help us in our planing for future mission programs.

May Abba Father bless you and take care of you in all your ways.
